

Dear All.

Students 4 Change, alongside the GSU and other groups are organizing a march from TCD's Front Square to the Dáil where we will hold a protest, on the 16th of October. We will march from College starting at 4pm, and we will hold this protest against Trinity in full public.

Last year, there were major shortfalls in learning outcomes and the student experience. This year, the value of our education continues to be compromised. We are protesting for our contractual rights, making our voices heard for inperson lectures, refunds for this year and last year and against Trinity's disregard for our mental health.

Our demands can be found here and have as their focus a refund of our fees due to online education and our reduced value for money, but are in essence more overarching. We demand to reverse the corporatization, loss of democracy and the for-profit model of the College, provide cheaper accommodation and start caring about the wellbeing of the College community, in addition to also placing importance on making education inclusive through hybrid-learning technologies and increased mental health support. If one University breaks the ranks and gives refunds, all will have to follow suit.
