Dear reader,

Students 4 Change, alongside the GSU and supported by the TCD Welfare Petition group are organizing a protest at Trinity's Front Entrance, on Wednesday 2nd of March. This will take place at 4pm.

We have organized this protest in light of recent tragic events at College, the death of Mark Melnychuk. The protest's demand is that no student or staff should have to wait more than a week to get help and to access College's counselling and health services. Based on a survey we did, these services have waiting times of months. Student testimonies as answers to our survey are attached to this email as an excel file and include direct quotes from students testifying this.

"Enough is enough. We are tired of seeing College and government funds being used to create fancy capital projects - spending 70 million € in 2020 on them - while neglecting student and staff mental health.

We believe human-centric budgeting is essential for our 20,000-strong College community and we do not subscribe to the consumerist interpretation of education which disregards all these considerations. Wellbeing is too often overlooked, and not given enough attention until tragedy strikes.

We demand that College invest so that no member of our community will have to wait more than 1 week to get help. If you agree, join us Wednesday at 4pm at TCD Front Entrance!"
