Students4Change and the Trinity Graduates' Students' Union (TCDGSU) have put out a [petition](#) and are calling for a protest at 9:30 am in front of the School of Business on Wednesday the 23rd of March, at the time of Trinity's Board meeting at the same place. Our College is putting forward an annual 2.3% fee increase for all cohorts for the next 4 years starting 2023/24, affecting non-EU and postgraduate students, which will be voted on at the meeting.
