Students4Change and the Trinity Graduate Students' Union have started a campaign in relation to grave concerns surrounding Minister Harris' new plan for the future of academia.

We believe that the plan of the government for third-level education is abysmal. Firstly, there is no commitment to reducing the student fees. Secondly, the funding is less than half of what our universities need. Thirdly, the plan comes with strings attached through the HEA Bill 2022, which is essentially a government takeover of academia.
